A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 2 of Title 8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, 2 relating to factory built buildings and dwelling units, so as to provide definitions; to provide 3 that a person who owns or has the right to use real property may install and occupy a 4 pre-owned manufactured home on such property under certain circumstances; to provide for 5 health and safety standards for pre-owned manufactured homes; to provide for certain 6 immunities; to prohibit certain regulations by local jurisdictions; to provide for related 7 matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes. 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA: 9 **SECTION 1.** Article 2 of Chapter 2 of Title 8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to 10 11 factory built buildings and dwelling units, is amended by adding a new part to read as 12 follows: 13 "Part 3A 14 8-2-170. 15 As used in this part, the term: 16 (1) 'Install' means to construct a foundation system and to place or erect a manufactured 17 home on such foundation system. Such term includes, without limitation, supporting, blocking, leveling, securing, or anchoring such manufactured home and connecting 18 19 multiple or expandable sections of such manufactured home. 20 (2) 'Manufactured home' means a structure, transportable in one or more sections, which, in the traveling mode, is eight body feet or more in width or 40 body feet or more in 21 22 length or, when erected on site, is 320 or more square feet and which is built on a permanent chassis and designed to be used as a dwelling with or without a permanent 23 24 foundation when connected to the required utilities and includes the plumbing, heating, 25 air-conditioning, and electrical systems contained therein; except that such term shall

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- 26 include any structure which meets all the requirements of this paragraph except the size 27 requirements and with respect to which the manufacturer voluntarily files a certification 28 required by the secretary of housing and urban development and complies with the 29 standards established under the National Manufactured Housing Construction and Safety Standards Act of 1974, 42 U.S.C. Section 5401, et seq. 30 31 (3) 'Pre-owned manufactured home' is any manufactured home that has been previously 32 used as a residential dwelling and has been titled. 33 <u>8-2-171.</u> 34 (a) On and after September 1, 2010, any person who is the owner of real property or who has a right to the use of real property may install and occupy a pre-owned manufactured 35 36 home on such property, provided that such pre-owned manufactured home is in compliance 37 with the provisions of this part and any applicable county or municipal zoning ordinances. (b) No county or municipality shall impose any health and safety standards or conditions 38 39 based upon the age of a manufactured home. (c) A county or municipality may establish health and safety standards and conditions and 40 41 an inspection program for pre-owned manufactured homes which are relocated from their 42 current locations. 43 (d) Neither a county or municipality nor any inspector thereof inspecting a pre-owned 44 manufactured home pursuant to this Code section shall be liable for any injuries to persons 45 resulting from any defects or conditions in such pre-owned manufactured home." 46 **SECTION 2.** 47 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law 48 without such approval.
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SECTION 3.

50 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
