

# millennial polling

In order to better understand the political landscape in advance of the midterm election, and from the point of view of American millennials, BuzzFeed News and Maru/Blue teamed up to conduct an online survey of **1,006** randomly selected 22-37- year-olds who are members of <u>Maru/Blue's</u> online panel <u>Springboard America</u>.

The study was run from the 21<sup>st</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> of September 2018 and, for comparison purposes, a probability sample of this size has an estimated margin of error (which measures sampling variability) of ±3%, 19 times out of 20.

The results have been weighted by age, gender, ethnicity and region to match the American population of 22-37-year-olds, according to Census data. This is to ensure a sample representative of the relevant adult population of America.

Discrepancies in or between totals are due to rounding. Bolded numbers indicate that the finding is significantly higher when compared to its counterpart.
