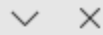

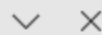

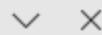

There are any number of reasons why the DOE may have opted not to mention any of the above. They include, but are not limited to:

- 1) No remarks were submitted.

- 3) Other factors, which may include 'political' or tactical reasons from the viewpoint of the DOE.

The first page of the DOE document stated the following.

"This document, concerning Manufactured Housing is an action issued by the Department of Energy. Though it is not intended or expected, should any discrepancy occur between the document posted here and the document published in the Federal Register, the Federal Register publication controls. This document is being made available through the Internet solely as a means to facilitate the public's access to this document."

Left-leaning Wikipedia explains that: "The Federal Register is the official journal of the federal government of the United States that contains government agency rules, proposed rules, and public notices. It is published every weekday, except on federal holidays."
