Boxabl's 190k reservations dwarf its 600 delivered (2023)—a cautionary tale vs. MH's 103,314 (2024, up 15.8%). The article's facts are mostly spot-on, save the 2024 MH glitch (fixed). HUD's preemption fumble holds both back—Boxabl's RV dodge flops, MH grows but could soar. BBB's 1/5 nails Boxabl's woes. Chase 2024 Boxabl numbers or HUD's next move? I'm on it if you say yes.
