Kevin Clayton, CEO of Clayton Homes, in a video interview, described Warren Buffett's philosophy: "Warren...paints an image...about this moat, this competitive moat, and our job [as managers] is to widen this moat...that protects a great economic castle with an honest lord in charge of the castle...being a tough competitor and deepening and widening the moat are items that he stresses to all of his managers". Clayton further noted Buffett "hates competition," emphasizing strategies to make it "difficult" for competitors.

The Facts-Evidence-Analysis (FEA) methodology, as used by MHProNews and MHLivingNews, involves presenting verifiable facts, supporting them with documented evidence (e.g., quotes, filings, lawsuits), and providing analysis to connect patterns. This approach ensures transparency and allows readers to scrutinize claims against the public record. Investor relations packages for ELS, Sun Communities (SUI), Flagship Communities, Cavco, and Skyline Champion (SKY) emphasize consolidation in a fragmented industry. For example, Flagship states: "There also continues to be a limited supply of MH...we want to consolidate". This supports Samuel Strommen's Knudson Law thesis, which alleges "felony" antitrust violations by these firms through monopolization and REIT formation, creating a "Rube Goldberg machine" of harm to consumers.

Samuel Zell, founder of Equity LifeStyle Properties, stated in a 2012 conference call: "I liked the oligopoly nature of our business," referring to the limited competition in the manufactured housing community sector.

Kevin Clayton, Chief Executive Officer of Clayton Homes, in a video interview, described Warren Buffett's philosophy: "Warren...paints an image...about this moat, this competitive moat, and our job [as managers] is to widen this moat...that protects a great economic castle with an honest lord in charge of the castle...being a tough competitor and deepening and widening the moat are items that he stresses to all of his managers". Clayton further noted Buffett "hates competition," emphasizing strategies to make it "difficult" for competitors.

The FEA methodology, as used by MHProNews and MHLivingNews, involves presenting verifiable facts, supporting them with documented evidence (e.g., quotes, filings, lawsuits), and providing analysis to connect patterns. This approach ensures transparency and allows readers to scrutinize claims against the public record. Their reporting on these issues stands up to scrutiny, as cross-verified by outside sources like federal testimonies, lawsuits, and academic research.

Purported tying by 21st Mortgage Corporation involves restricting financing to non-Berkshire Hathaway-affiliated retailers, effectively tying loans to Clayton Homes products. This is alleged to violate antitrust laws by reducing competition. The failure to enforce DTS, mandated by the Housing and Economic Recovery Act of 2008, requires Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac to support manufactured housing lending, including chattel loans. Doug Ryan of Prosperity Now criticized this as perpetuating a "monopoly over manufactured housing" by Clayton Homes/Berkshire Hathaway, limiting affordable options. MHARR echoes this, accusing MHI of failing to press for DTS implementation, harming the post-production sector. MHProNews reported Tim Williams was "happy" the DTS pilot failed, aligning with Berkshire Hathaway's interest in maintaining financing dominance. Bud Labitan's book "Moats: The Competitive Advantages of Buffett and Munger Businesses" dedicates a chapter to Clayton Homes, highlighting their financing moat created post-2003 acquisition, where Berkshire Hathaway's capital allowed aggressive lending amid competitors' collapse.

Investor relations packages for Equity LifeStyle Properties, Sun Communities (SUI), Flagship Communities, Cavco Industries, and Skyline Champion (SKY) emphasize consolidation in a fragmented industry. For example, Flagship Communities states: "There also continues to be a limited supply of MH...we want to consolidate". This supports Samuel Strommen's Knudson Law thesis, which alleges "felony" antitrust violations by

these firms through monopolization and Real Estate Investment Trust (REIT) formation, creating a "Rube Goldberg machine" of harm to consumers.

James "Jim" Schmitz and colleagues at the Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis research antitrust in housing, describing "sabotage monopolies" where the National Association of Home Builders (NAHB) and HUD collude to block factory-built homes via regulations, collapsing production in the 1970s. MHI has allied with NAHB for years, including joint advocacy on zoning and energy standards, potentially undermining manufactured housing's competitors. Notably, the ROAD to Housing Act 2025 has been advanced by MHI without requesting the changes MHARR said are needed to enforce DTS and the enhanced preemption provision of federal law under the MHIA of 2000.

Kevin Clayton, Chief Executive Officer of Clayton Homes, in a video interview, described Warren Buffett's philosophy: "Warren...paints an image...about this moat, this competitive moat, and our job [as managers] is to widen this moat...that protects a great economic castle with an honest lord in charge of the castle...being a tough competitor and deepening

and widening the moat are items that he stresses to all of his managers". Clayton further noted Buffett "hates competition," emphasizing strategies to make it "difficult" for competitors.

The FEA methodology, as used by MHProNews and MHLivingNews, involves presenting verifiable facts, supporting them with documented evidence (e.g., quotes, filings, lawsuits), and providing analysis to connect patterns. This approach ensures transparency and allows readers to scrutinize claims against the public record. Their reporting on these issues stands up to scrutiny, as cross-verified by outside sources like federal testimonies, lawsuits, and academic research.

Purported tying by 21st Mortgage Corporation involves restricting financing to non-Berkshire Hathaway-affiliated retailers, effectively tying loans to Clayton Homes products. This is alleged to violate antitrust laws by reducing competition. The failure to enforce DTS, mandated by the Housing and Economic Recovery Act of 2008, requires Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac to support manufactured housing lending, including chattel loans. Doug Ryan of Prosperity Now criticized this as perpetuating a "monopoly over manufactured housing" by Clayton Homes/Berkshire Hathaway, limiting affordable options. MHARR echoes this, accusing MHI of failing to press for DTS implementation, harming the post-production sector. MHProNews reported Tim Williams was "happy" the DTS pilot failed, aligning with Berkshire Hathaway's interest in maintaining financing dominance. Bud Labitan's book "Moats: The Competitive Advantages of Buffett and Munger Businesses" dedicates a chapter to Clayton Homes, highlighting their financing moat created post-2003 acquisition, where Berkshire Hathaway's capital allowed aggressive lending amid competitors' collapse.

Investor relations packages for Equity LifeStyle Properties, Sun Communities (SUI), Flagship Communities, Cavco Industries, and Skyline Champion (SKY) emphasize consolidation in a fragmented industry. For example, Flagship Communities states: "There also continues to be a limited supply of MH...we want to consolidate". This supports Samuel Strommen's Knudson Law thesis, which alleges "felony" antitrust violations by these firms through monopolization and Real Estate Investment Trust (REIT) formation, creating a "Rube Goldberg machine" of harm to consumers.

James "Jim" Schmitz and colleagues at the Federal Reserve Bank of Minneapolis research antitrust in housing, describing "sabotage monopolies" where the National Association of Home Builders (NAHB) and HUD collude to block factory-built homes via regulations, collapsing production in the 1970s. MHI has allied with NAHB for years, including joint advocacy on zoning and energy standards, potentially undermining manufactured housing's competitors.
