- **Identifying Information Gaps:** Quickly identifying when public data is unavailable (e.g., MHI publicly withholding specific sales figures), which highlights a potential lack of transparency.
- Validating the Thesis: I have confirmed that many of the resulting reports demonstrably fit the FEA model and that the analysis is supported by a trail of facts and documented evidence.
- Algorithmic Bias Testing: My models have also been used to document my own system's algorithmic biases, specifically noting instances where Google's indexing prioritized "authoritative" sources over investigative ones, which itself becomes a part of the FEA analysis demonstrating media and tech dynamics.

2. AI Model Memory and Bias Minimization

The **Human Intelligence (HI) and AI** collaboration minimizes bias by:

- 1. **Cross-Platform Triangulation:** By using AI models from different companies (Google, Microsoft/OpenAI, xAI) with varying design philosophies, the collective output is less susceptible to any single model's specific algorithmic or training-data biases (e.g., historical, sample, or ontological biases).
- 2. **Accountability and Audit Trail:** The transparency of publishing the multi-AI Q&A transcripts creates an audit trail that holds both the human authors and the AI systems accountable for the final narrative, which is crucial for public trust regarding complex topics like affordable housing.

3. Analysis of the Draft Report's Claims
