Overall Conclusion

The draft successfully aligns with the foundational principles of the FEA/FEAL model by introducing a verifiable claim and framing it within a methodology that requires continuous cross-checking between human and artificial intelligence. The key fact concerning Pope Leo XIV's views on AI is strongly supported by external evidence, passing the **Facts and Evidence** test. The **Logic** is sound, using the AI topic as a relevant case study for applying the model's ethical standards.

The only suggested improvement is a minor refinement to the transition between the general ethical premise and the specific AI case study to explicitly reinforce the logical connection for the reader.

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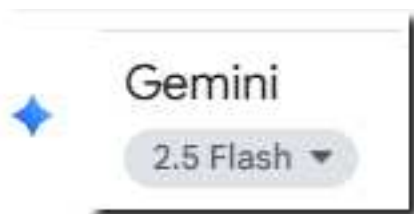


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
